A First Workshop on autism: This workshop is for anyone living or working with children or young people who are on the autism spectrum. You will learn what autism is, how a diagnosis is made, and what is meant by the "autism spectrum". The workshop also covers challenges faced by carers, parents, and schools, as well as how children and young people on the spectrum experience their autism. The session is for you if you are a parent, teacher, learning support assistant, or anyone else who would like to learn more about autism. A First Workshop on Behaviour Management for pupils with ASD, dyspraxia, and ADHD: This workshop is suitable for teachers, SENCOs, and support staff who would like an introduction to managing the difficult behaviour of children with a variety of "learning difficulties". You will learn about the major challenges faced by pupils with Autism, dyspraxia, and ADHD in the school environment. The session also covers a model for thinking about behaviour that takes into account the children's difficulties with processing information. On the practical side, we will discuss some examples of behavioural challenges drawn from participants' experience.

A First Workshop on Asperger's Syndrome: This workshop complements *A First Workshop on Autism*. You will be given an introduction to Asperger's syndrome (AS) and the challenges and opportunities for pupils with this diagnosis. The session also focuses on some of the most difficult challenges faced by children and young people with AS, such as sensory sensitivity and social skills.

Master Class: Extreme behaviour in autism - teaching pupils self regulation.

In this session, we review the human stress response which is activated in situations where extreme behaviour occurs. We also consider the stages and steps involved in teaching pupils to self-manage their emotions. The principles and techniques discussed are relevant to a wide range of behavioural problems seen in children and young people. *Master Classes are recommended for participants who already have a good knowledge of autism.*

Each of the above workshops costs only £95.00 (inc). All course notes, refreshments, and a certificate of attendance are provided. (Lunches are not included).

Free event!!! Creating autism friendly schools: This is a FREE practice sharing and problem solving seminar for senior school leaders and school governors. This event is open to heads, deputy heads, SENCOs and other senior school leaders from primary and secondary schools only. Participants will be given the opportunity to identify the issues they face in their schools with integrating pupils with autism spectrum conditions into the mainstream. Opportunities will be provided for sharing ideas, examples of best practice, and finding creative ways to address common issues. We anticipate that this will be a popular session, so please contact us as soon as possible for your free place. Numbers will be strictly limited, and no more than two participants per school will be enrolled in the session.
